- 10am** Enjoy breakfast, learn advocacy tips, & practice sharing your story.
- 12:30pm** Lunch.
- 2pm** Visit your members of Congress.
- 5:30pm** Join SAGE staff & activists at the Capitol Hill Reception. Light snacks will be served.
- 7pm** Eat dinner & ride the bus back to the Edie Windsor SAGE Center. Expect to return by 11:30pm.

Information

You DON'T need to be a policy expert.

You DO need to share your story about being an LGBT older person.

If you bring a coat, bag, or other personal item off the bus, you must carry them throughout the day.

You will spend time walking from the bus stop to Senate office buildings, offices of Members of Congress, and the reception.

Capitol Hill facilities are accessible to people with disabilities; SAGE will accommodate those with disabilities.

You will most likely meet with Congressional staff, not actual members of Congress.
