SAGECare has trained 50,000+ eldercare providers in LGBT CULTURAL COMPETENCY

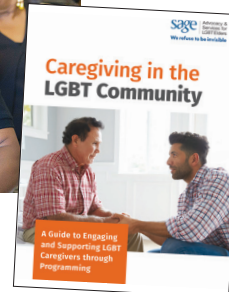


SAGE has mobilized the LGBT community and allies to **demand change** from the federal government on LGBT aging issues.

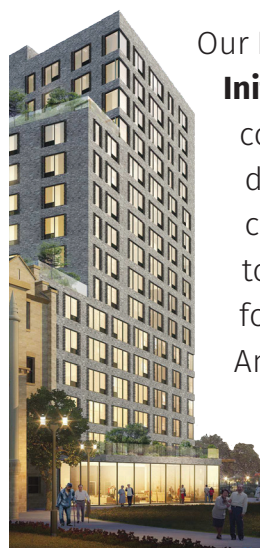
Our relationship-building programs, such as **SAGE Table**, bring older and younger LGBT people together to create ties across generations.
